Mumugu Resident Enthusiastically Placed The Indonesian Flag With Habema Soldiers

NDUGA- The Task Forces of the Para Raider Infantry Battalion 503/Mayangkara Kostrad, one of the military units under the command of the Indonesian Armed Forces Operational Command (KOOPS TNI) HABEMA in Papua, is currently conducting the mobile security at the border of Indonesia and Papua New Guinea, especially in Nduga Regency area, Papua Pegunungan Province. On Wednesday, 7 August 2024.

To welcome the 79th Anniversary of the Independence of the Republic of Indonesia, residents of Mumugu Village, Krepkuri District, together with Soldiers of the 503 Task Forces, carried out the installation of the Indonesian Flag in public areas and on public roadsides. During the installation, the Soldiers took the time to conduct Social Communication (Komsos) with the Mumugu residents about the importance of maintaining regional security to support development in the Papua region.

Finally, upon the decision on the time and location for the installation, the residents conducted the installation enthusiastically with the Soldiers. One of the residents, Menja Firkom, enthusiastically said, "Commander 503, let's install the Indonesian Flags together. Long live Indonesia." This historic moment filled the residents with a sense of pride and unity.
